Caso 2: Trastorno de ansiedad generalizada (TAG)

Historia clínica: Una mujer de 42 años reporta preocupación excesiva y persistente sobre diferentes aspectos de su vida, como su trabajo, salud y relaciones, que dura más de seis meses. Además, presenta tensión muscular, fatiga y dificultades para dormir.

Evaluación con DSM-5: Para diagnosticar TAG, se consideran: - Ansiedad y preocupación excesivas en la mayoría de los días durante al menos seis meses. - Dificultad para controlar la preocupación. - Presencia de al menos tres de los siguientes síntomas: -

Inquietud o sensación de estar "en marcha". - Fatiga fácil. - Dificultad para

concentrarse. - Irritabilidad. - Tensión muscular. - Problemas de sueño. Aplicación

clínica: El caso cumple con los criterios diagnósticos, dado que la preocupación es persistente, excesiva y acompañada de síntomas físicos y cognitivos.

Caso 3: Trastorno de estrés postraumático (TEPT)

Historia clínica: Un individuo de 28 años sufrió un accidente grave hace tres meses, que involucró violencia y peligro para su vida. Desde entonces, experimenta flashbacks, pesadillas recurrentes, evitación de lugares relacionados con el evento y aumento de la excitación.

Evaluación con DSM-5: Los criterios para TEPT incluyen: - Exposición a un evento traumático. - Presencia de síntomas en cada una de las siguientes categorías: - Intrusiones (flashbacks, pesadillas). - Evitación (lugares, personas, actividades relacionados con el trauma). - Alteraciones negativas en cogniciones y estado de ánimo.

- Aumento de la excitación (hipervigilancia, irritabilidad). - Duración de los síntomas superior a un mes. - Impacto en el funcionamiento social, laboral o personal. Aplicación

clínica: El paciente cumple con los criterios, presentando síntomas en todas las categorías, con duración superior a un mes y impacto significativo.

Cómo utilizar el DSM-5 para casos clínicos complejos

Plan de tratamiento:

1. Antipsicóticos de segunda generación.
2. Terapia psicosocial y apoyo familiar.
